Juan Carlos Castilla Zenobi, received a PH.D. in Marine Biology (1970) from the University of North Wales (GB). He is involved in several international projects of marine contamination, aquaculture, marine ecology, Invertebrate Resources, systematic of gastropods and mollusks, development coastal sector,...

The main lines of research refer to rocky intertidal community structure and dynamics and the role played by humans as resource users. Additionally, he is interested in the establishment in Chile of Marine Coastal Preserve Areas (MCPAs) and Management and Exploitation Areas (MEAs); allocated to small artisanal fisher communities under exclusive resource use rights; and the linkages between them and conservation, management and benthic biodiversity. Coastal inshore oceanography is a research area of recent development in Chile on which he is actively working.

He is Correspondent Member of the Chilean Academy of Sciences (2002) in biological Oceanography area.
